## Climate Responsible Special Events (CRSE) Tier Requirements, Fees, and Rebates

Thank you for considering making your event more climate responsible! To align with the Town's Climate Action Plan, we have replaced the Striving for Zero Waste initiative with a measurable, Climate Responsible Special Events (CRSE) tiered system. Depending on which tier your event falls under, you may be charged a CRSE fee. However, the Town is offering cash rebates to help offset some costs of reducing waste at your event. To be eligible for an event tier's fee and rebate amount, your event must meet <u>all</u> requirements within that tier. Rebates must be requested **within 30 days** following your event. Tiers are separated by both food and non-food events. If your event serves food or beverages in any capacity, please reference the "Food Events" CRSE requirements. Bolded requirements indicate the additional requirements from the tier below it.

To be eligible for your reduced CRSE fee and/or rebate, you must submit:

## Before the event:

☐ The Climate Responsible Special Event worksheet *with* your special event application. The worksheet can be found on the Town's Special Events webpage under the Climate Responsible Special Events banner.

## After the event:

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☐ The CRSE post event survey. A link to the survey can be found on the Town's Special Events webpage under the Climate Responsible Special Events banner.

All CRSE forms, receipts, and questions should be submitted to: specialevents@crestedbutte-co.gov. The post-event survey will ask about the types and amounts of waste your event collected, so please keep that in mind as you conduct your event. We recommend viewing the survey ahead of your event.

The Town recognizes that in some cases the CRSE fees may cause hardship or an undue burden to an event holder's ability to host their event. If you feel that your event cannot be carried out due to this program, you may access the 2024 CRSE Fee Hardship Waiver on the Town's Special Events webpage under the Climate Responsible Special Events banner.
