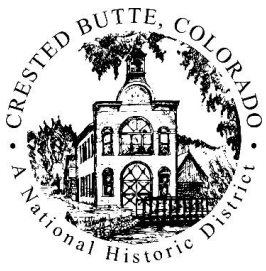


SNOW MANAGEMENT PERMIT APPLICATION PACKET

Snow Management Permit Application

Please include in your application submission the following items:

- Completed and signed *Snow Management Permit Application*
- Completed and signed *Gravel Pit Sub-Application* (optional)
- Certificate or Proof of Insurance naming the Town as additionally insured
- Highlighted map showing extents of work
- \$50 Check made out to the Town of Crested Butte
- Additional and separate \$750 (\$500 fee + \$250 deposit) Check made out to the Town of Crested Butte **only if applying for the Gravel Pit**

Upon Acceptance of this application, you will be given a windshield sticker to display upon your permitted snow removal vehicles. The Town will conduct inspections from time to time to ensure that all vehicles conducting snow management in town have their stickers. **Please display these stickers on the top, passenger-side of the rear windshield if possible. Otherwise, place sticker on the rear of the vehicle on the passenger side.**

Should a vehicle not be properly displaying a permit sticker it will be subject to citation.





Snow Management Permit Application

Any person permitted to haul, dump, transport or store snow within Town shall comply with the following requirements:

- (1) Keep and maintain in force at all times during the performance of such activities a snow management permit issued by the Town Manager*
- (2) Provide the Town with a certificate of insurance naming the Town as an additional insured reflecting coverage satisfactory to the Town Manager.*
- (3) Snow stored on Town-owned property, public rights of way, streets and alleys shall be removed no later than May 1st of each year, except as otherwise permitted by the Town Manager in writing.*
- (4) Snow accumulated in alleys shall be hauled away within 72 hours after the snow has reached a point of 1/2 the height of any adjacent fence line, or as deemed necessary by Town Manager.*
- (5) Persons hauling, dumping, transporting or storing snow within Town shall be responsible and liable for any damage to private and public property as set forth in this snow management permit.*
- (6) Heavy equipment such as loaders and dump trucks are not permitted Red Lady Ave. or on 9th St. adjacent to the Community School during the hours of 8:00am-8:45am Monday-Friday and 3:15pm-3:45pm Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and 1:30pm-2:15pm Wednesdays*

This Snow Management Permit shall expire on the 1st of May after the date of issuance.

I hereby certify that I have read and examined this application and that all information in this application is true and correct. The granting of a permit does not presume to give authority to violate or cancel provisions of any other state or local law regulating commercial vehicle operations. Further, I understand that the violation of any of the provisions previously set forth shall be deemed a misdemeanor and upon conviction of any such violation I shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or, by such fine and imprisonment for each and every day.

Snow Management Permit Application

Gravel Pit Sub-Application

If you would like to reserve one of five dedicated plots in the Town’s “Gravel Pit”, please sign and submit this page with the Snow Management Permit Application. Please be aware that space is limited and if there are more than five applicants, plots will be awarded based on a lottery system. Applicants will have to pay the applicable permit fee and bond only after being awarded the plot.

The amount of \$ 500.00 (permit fee) shall be paid at the time of submittal of this application to defray the Town’s costs and expenses in connection with processing this application and issuing the permit. A \$250.00 bond, made payable to the Town of Crested Butte, shall be paid at the time of submittal. The cash bond will be returned at the end of the permit period if no damage has been incurred as a result of snow hauling operations.

In consideration for the Town granting the permit to operate trucks on Town streets and snow storage area at the Town gravel pit, Owner(s)/Applicant(s), its heirs, successors, assigns and transferees (collectively, “Releasor/Indemnitor”) hereby acknowledge and agree as to the following: (i) Releasor/Indemnitor assume all risk of claims, liabilities, injuries, losses, demands or damages, whether related to bodily injury, personal injury, sickness, disease, death, property loss or damage (including attorneys’ fees, costs and expenses) (collectively, “Claims”) arising out of the permit granted pursuant to this application, whether or not caused by the act or omission, negligence or other fault of Releasor/Indemnitor; (ii) Releasor/Indemnitor waive and release the Town from any and all Claims arising out of the permit granted pursuant to this application, whether or not caused by the act or omission, negligence or other fault of Releasor/Indemnitor; (iii) Releasor/Indemnitor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Town from and against any and all Claims arising out of the permit granted pursuant to this application, whether or not caused by the act or omission, negligence or other fault of Releasor/Indemnitor. For purposes hereof, the term “Town” shall include, individually and collectively, the Town of Crested Butte, its elected officials, officers, employees, agents, insurers, insurance pools, attorneys, contractors and subcontractors.

As an applicant for a Town of Crested Butte Snow Storage Permit, I hereby affirm that the information provided on the application is accurate. I understand that providing incorrect or false information may result in the revocation of this permit being applied for herein. I understand that operating outside the requirements of the permit pursuant hereto, may also be grounds for revocation of said permit and the privileges granted thereunder. My signature below indicates that I have read and understand the conditions of permit and the contents of this application, and the information I have provided is true and correct.
